- Maryland hospitals need the public's help to ensure that hospital resources—including limited staff—are being used efficiently.
 - To help ease crowding in Maryland hospitals' emergency departments:
 - Use hospital emergency rooms only for TRUE emergencies
 - Call your doctor or use urgent care for non-life-threatening issues
 - Try a telehealth visit if you're just unsure about your condition and need answers from a professional
 - Get vaccinated, get boosted, wear a mask, and practice social distancing.
