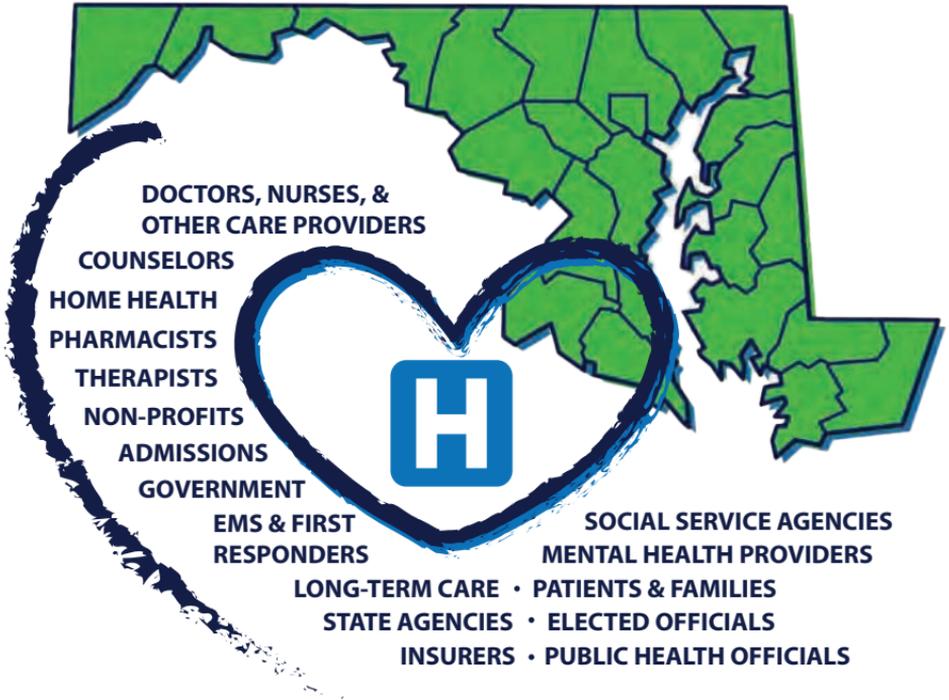


# CARE TAKES ALL OF US.
